Barnet battle lost

Barnet Council has lost its appeal over the development of 43 retirement flats on the old Texaco garage site in the High Road. As a result the developers, McCarthy and Stone, will now be able to build the flats without including any affordable housing.

The decision of the Court of Appeal ends a long running battle over the site which began when the council refused to grant McCarthy and Stone planning permission. The developers successfully appealed to the government Planning Inspector who accepted their claim that including affordable housing would render the development unprofitable. Barnet then appealed to the High Court and won only for the developers to take the case to the Court of Appeal. The Court of Appeal

overturned the High Court decision and so the inspector's decision to grant planning permission stands.

Need for houses

Although the council is committed to ensuring that affordable housing is included in all developments it now accepts that this particular battle has been lost. The council says that it has no regrets about pursuing the case and will continue to stress the need for developers to include affordable housing in their plans.
