Art Exhibition With the snow starting to fall outside on what was a beautiful clear evening, guests gathered at the church for a drinks reception and a chance to mingle and view the exhibition, organised in conjunction with 'East Finchley Open', a new initiative by artists and craftspeople living and working in East Finchley and the Barnet area. "We want to increase the visibility of local artists and are hoping to organise a group show of some kind to coincide with the East Finchley Festival", said David Aronsohn who co-ordinated the exhibi-

Surprise

As part of the carefully selected musical programme The Ellerdale Trio had chosen Bergerettes by Boshuslav Martinu, as it is a particular favourite in their concert repertoire. At the end of the concert the Trio surprised everyone by returning to play Spiegel im Spiegel by Arvo Pärt, an ethereal piece of music which suited the mood of the evening perfectly.

Although a familiar face at Martin Schools where she leads the singing and plays the piano for the nursery children each week, Sarah Down is a much in demand professional pianist and a founder member of The Ellerdale Trio. "We couldn't have done this without Sarah," said Catrin Dillon, "and we're extremely grateful to her."
