## Planning Applications

**5 Beaumont Close, N2 (The Lodge)**

Proposed alteration and extension of existing garage structure to provide bedroom accommodation within the attic.

### 26A Church Lane, N2

Erection of a single storey front extension to provide increased office space following demolition of existing conservatory.

### 38A Church Lane, N2

Creation of first floor roof terrace to rear involving installation of privacy screening.

### 255 Creighton Avenue, N2

Part single, part two storey rear extension including balcony. Extension to roof including removal of chimneys and rear dormer to facilitate a loft conversion. Conversion of garage into habitable room. First floor front/side extension.

### 5 Hamilton Road, N2

Single storey rear extension.

### 83 High Road, N2

Second floor rear extension.

### 111 High Road, N2

Single storey rear extension.

### 248A High Road, N2

Retention of front lights and formation of new dormer window to rear to facilitate a loft conversion. Retention of new door to first floor side elevation with accompanying fire escape staircase. Repositioning of gable window.

Formation of new access door within existing window opening to form entrance to ground floor unit (suite 2).

## Plain clothes patrols pay off

**Four men were arrested for burglary in Creighton Avenue on 15 February.**

PC Eddie Rose, who made the arrests, became suspicious when he saw the men eyeing up the houses on the avenue. The men were unaware they were being watched as the police officer was in plain clothes and driving an unmarked car. When PC Rose spotted the men emerging from a back garden he arrested them, with help from

other members of the Safer Neighbourhood Team. They have all been bailed pending further enquiries.
