Now in their eleventh year, the council's annual awards recognise the commitment and hard work of men and women living or working within the borough who regularly give up their own time to make a positive difference to the lives of others.

All nominees will receive a certificate, with those deemed to have made the greatest contribution to borough life, being presented with a framed vellum by the Mayor of Barnet, Councillor Anthony Finn, at an awards ceremony in March.

All entries must be received by or on 31 December 2010 with nominations received after this date not accepted. Judging will take place in February.

Last year's winners

Last year's winners included THE ARCHER team, 'in recognition of all of the dedicated volunteers who produce and deliver the newspaper'; Ms Hanan Ibrahim, in recognition of her work as founder and Chief Executive of the Somali Family Support Group in Barnet; and Dr Margaret Clark, for her outstanding work in supporting cancer sufferers in Barnet, and as founder of Barnet Cancer Care.

The Mayor of Barnet, Councillor Anthony Finn said: "It is important we continue to recognise those people who give their spare time to helping others. They are the people who we can truly consider the cornerstone of our community."

Councillors of the London Borough of Barnet and previous winners are not eligible for nomination.
