Forgotten your Census form?

If you didn't complete your Census form, you may receive a visit from Census officers. The Safer Neighbourhood Team has informed us that officers have been visiting addresses to interview people since May and will continue calling on residents until mid-August.

All visits will be carried out by two officers who will be wearing official identification cards. If they don't get a reply, they may call back at different times of the day in order to make contact with the household. We understand that they won't call after 9pm without first making an appointment.

Double break-in

Burglars broke into two homes in St Pancras Court, High Road, on 17 June. The front door of one property was forced open sometime between 6.30pm and 7.30pm. It looks as if the burglar was disturbed because papers and other items were strewn around the rooms, but nothing was taken.

Between 9.30pm and 9.45pm, a nearby property also had an intruder, who stole a watch. This time the burglar entered by climbing through an open balcony window.

"If doors or windows are left open, it encourages criminals to the area," said a police spokesperson. Anyone who saw anything suspicious is asked to call 101, quoting crime reference numbers 2414838/11 and 2414844/1. If you want to remain anonymous, call Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111.

It's 101 for London's police

A new police contact number has been launched after an analysis of records revealed that fewer than a quarter of 999 calls need an emergency response.

You should dial 999 if an immediate response is needed because a crime is happening; someone suspected of a crime is nearby; or someone is injured, being threatened or in danger.

You should dial 101 to report a crime that has already happened, to get advice or to raise local policing issues.

The new number, 101, will be manned 24 hours a day, seven days a week, by specially trained officers. For people who

speaking little or no English, their calls to 101 will be connected to an interpreter. Callers who are deaf, deafened or have a speech impairment can use a textphone to call 18001 101, or, in an emergency, 18000.

The 101 number replaces the previous number for non-urgent police calls 0300 123 1212. If you want to report a crime anonymously, the Crimestoppers number 0800 555 111 still applies.
