## Planning Applications

**74 Bedford Road, N2**  
Single-storey side extension to existing rear addition, including raising roof of existing addition.

**39 Brim Hill, N2**  
New patio doors and window to rear of play room. New window to utility room. Erection of new shed in rear garden, following removal of existing one. Loft conversion, including roof lights.

**2 Deansway, N2**  
Single-storey rear extension.

**6 Durham Road, N2**  
Conversion of three bedsits into one self-contained flat on first floor.

**7 Fairlawn Avenue, N2**  
Single-storey rear extension, following demolition of existing rear addition.

**3 Greenhalgh Walk, N2**  
Single-storey rear extension; side and rear roof lights; convert garage and change door; change front door; double glazed doors in rear elevation; extend hard landscaping at rear; new shed; and associated works.

**44 High Road, N2**  
Single-storey rear extension to existing shop and installation of new shop front. Conversion of one studio residential unit into one residential self-contained flat.

**58-60 High Road, N2**  
Single-storey rear extensions to commercial units and four car parking spaces at rear.

**125 High Road, N2**  
Alterations to existing shop front, including replacement of front window to create new front entrance door; replacement of existing front door with fully glazed window; insertion of three additional windows to match existing at Kitchener Road elevation.

Dual use of retail shop as retail sales of physiotherapy equipment (A1), and use for physiotherapy treatments (D1).

## Barnet pharmacies to offer flu jabs

**NHS Barnet PCT is offering flu jabs to most at-risk groups this year. Vaccinations will be offered at GP surgeries but also at a number of pharmacies in Barnet, including CW Andrew in East Finchley High Road, as they are often more accessible than GP surgeries.**

Flu jabs will be available in early October, and will be administered free of charge to qualifying patients who are registered with a Barnet GP.

People in at-risk groups, which include people aged 65 years or over and those with certain conditions such as chronic respiratory or heart disease, are encouraged to take up the offer of vaccination against the annual outbreak of seasonal influenza this winter.

Flu is much more serious than the common cold.

Flu symptoms can hit you suddenly and severely. They usually include fever, chills, headaches, aching muscles, coughing and a sore throat, all at the same time. For susceptible people, this can develop into more serious illnesses such as bronchitis and pneumonia, and in the worst cases, a stay in hospital, or even death.

People who are not eligible for a free vaccination can take advantage of the private services provided by many pharmacies such as CW Andrew.
