## Planning Applications

### Barnet Council

#### Bald Faced Stag, 69 High Road, N2

Alterations to rear parking area. Includes reduction of parking spaces to facilitate new patio, new grassed area with feature planting bed, and bin store. Alterations to ground floor rear fenestration, including new entrance doors and steps and opening, bi-folding replacement windows. Blocking up one north-facing window. Glazed lantern to flat roof of dining-room.

#### 12 Deansway, N2

Creation of basement level with terrace above. Changes to rear windows and doors. Roof extension, involving replacing rooflights with two rear dormer windows.

#### 4 Hamilton Road, N2

Single-storey rear infill extension.

#### 70 Hamilton Road, N2

Single-storey side/rear extension with associated roof over.

#### 44 High Road, N2

One fascia sign and one projected sign, both internally illuminated.

#### 35 Huntingdon Road, N2

Conversion of two self-contained flats into one dwelling-house, including single-storey rear and garden terrace extension. Replacement of PVC rear windows with original sliding sash units.

#### 340 Long Lane, N2

Single-storey rear extension. Proposed depth 6m from original

rear wall. Eaves and maximum heights 10m.

#### 62 Manor Park Road, N2

Roof extension, involving one front roof light, two side/rear roof lights, and one rear dormer window with roof light, to facilitate loft conversion. Changes to rear window.

#### 68 Park Hall Road, N2

Single-storey side/rear extension. Roof extension, including rear dormer window, and second floor extension on existing flat roof to rear projection, to facilitate loft conversion.

#### Strawberry Vale, involving 1-27 Nursery Road, 1-29 Brook Walk and 1-42 Stable Walk, N2

Replacement of single-glazed windows and doors with new double-glazed ones.

Security gates and wall to front of property.

Single-storey rear extension and rear dormer.

## Council election results

**The Conservative Party has retained overall control of Barnet Council, but only just. In an evening of high drama as the results were announced on 23 May, the Conservatives were reduced to 32 councillors as Labour, despite making significant gains, fell short of gaining control. The Liberal Democrat presence on the council has been reduced to one.**

In East Finchley, Labour councillors Allison Moore and Arjun Mitra were re-elected, with Alon Or-Bach becoming one of 18 new councillors in Barnet.
