75 Brim Hill, N2

Roof extension, with one side and one rear roof light and one side dormer, to facilitate loft conversion.

5 & 7 Chandos Road, N2

Replacement of existing rear extension with single-storey rear extension with two roof lights.

18 Chandos Road, N2

Refurbishment of rear extension, plus new infill extension.

40 Church Lane, N2

Single-storey rear extension. First and second-floor rear extensions. One ground-floor studio and two one-bedroom flats at first and second floor levels.

235 Creighton Avenue, N2

First-floor side extension. Roof extension to facilitate rear dormer.

20 Elmfield Road, N2

Single-storey rear. Proposed depth of 5.24 m. from rear wall, eaves height 2.74 m., maximum height 4 m.

20 Elmhurst Avenue, N2

Erection of front porch.

Flat 4, 13 Fortis Green, N2

Jogger attacked on Hampstead Heath

A 30-year-old woman was attacked while jogging on Hampstead Heath. She was punched and knocked to the ground as she approached Wildwood Road on Monday 21 July at about 11.30pm.

Her attacker, described as a white man about 5ft 9ins tall, repeatedly punched her in the back of the head as she lay on the ground, causing swelling and bruising. He ripped off her earrings and headphones, cutting her scalp, and then ran off.

In a separate incident on 18 July, a 29-year-old woman was attacked at about 10.30pm while making her way home from the Boardwalk shopping centre in Edgware. A man came up behind her and struck her on the back of the head with a can of drink, while she was walking down Church Way. He then punched her several times in the face. In the struggle they both fell to the ground and the woman injured her shoulder. The man ran off when the woman screamed to alert passers-by.

He is described as white, stocky, about 5ft 6ins tall with short blond hair and facial stubble. He spoke with an Irish accent.

The police say that the two incidents are not linked. "I need the public's help to identify these violent men before they strike again," said DC Mike Clinch from Barnet CID.
