Tim moves on after 10 years

Pupils and staff at Holy Trinity Primary School will say farewell to their headteacher Tim Bowden at the end of this month.

Tim, who has led the one-form-entry primary school in Eagans Close for 10 years, is moving on to lead Hillyfield Primary Academy in Waltham Forest.

Hillyfield is a six-form entry school with more than 900 children on its roll and it is expected to grow over the next five years to reach a full capacity of 1,400 pupils.

Tim has been an inspirational headteacher for the hundreds of youngsters who have passed through Holy Trinity under his care. Parents and staff have appreciated the hard work and drive he has brought to his role and the friendly atmosphere of learning and positive support he spread throughout the school.

Outstanding

During his time as headteacher he has overseen the transformation of Holy Trinity's outdoor facilities, including an outdoor classroom, garden area and new playground facilities. Most recently, his staff and pupils have been rewarded with an 'Outstanding' rating from

their latest Ofsted inspection.

Tim himself says: "It's been 10 great years and a fantastic journey. Thanks to the whole school community, especially the children and my fabulous staff. I leave the

school in a great place and I know it will continue to thrive." Deputy headteacher Roz Kimani will act as interim head for the next academic year while the school governors seek to fill the role on a permanent basis.

New head at Academy

The governors at the Archer Academy have announced the appointment of Lucy Harrison as the school's new headteacher to replace Mick Quigley.

A statement said: "Lucy has been the deputy headteacher from day one, and has been a driving force in establishing the school and developing its excellent reputation. She is a familiar, trusted face to everyone in the school community, popular with and respected by staff, students and parents alike."

Speaking of her appointment, Lucy said: "I am thor-

oughly looking forward to supporting the staff, students and parents of the Archer Academy over the coming years and building on the strong foundations we have in place."

She will officially take up the post in September 2015 as the school moves to its new Stanley Road campus. Mr Quigley, who has led the school since it opened in 2013, is relocating to Malaysia with his wife.

Reward offered over arson attack

Police are offering a £5,000 reward for information leading to the prosecution of those responsible for the arson attack on the Somali Bravanese community centre in Coppetts Road, Muswell Hill, in the early hours of 5 June 2013.

The fire completely destroyed the centre which has since been demolished. Graffiti reading 'EDL' was found on the outside of the building and police are treating the incident as a hate crime. No arrests have yet been made.

Specialist officers from the Met's Counter-Terrorism Command are leading the investigation and detectives continue to appeal for anyone with information to get in touch. They would like to hear from anyone who was in the vicinity of Coppetts Road on the evening of 4 June or the early hours of 5 June.

They are also looking for information about a light-coloured Toyota Corolla Verso car, which was seen very close to the centre immediately before the fire was started. They are keen to identify and trace either the driver, the owner, or anyone with any information about the vehicle.

"We are still determined to identify the person or persons responsible for this act," said Superintendent Paula Light. "I would urge anybody with information to call 020 7230 3046 or to contact Crimestoppers, which is completely anonymous, on 0800 555 111. It's not too late."
