Pedestrian dies after collision



A 38-year-old man died after an accident involving a bus on the flyover where the High Road crosses the North Circular.

Police were called to the scene at 7.30am on Tuesday 25 August following reports of a pedestrian in collision with a northbound bus. Orlando Carbungco, 38, of Henderson Road, N9, was taken to hospital in a critical condition and died from his injuries two days later. The bus driver stopped at the scene and no arrests have been made.
