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## How Big Local cash will be spent

### The two-year plan

Over the next two years, GBL will work with other organisations and volunteers to:

- Tackle neglected footpaths, starting with the dingy and dangerous underpass between Manor Park Road and Trinity Road
- Develop a local advice service, a much needed resource since the Neighbourhood Centre on Church Lane was closed
- Work with the council to make a cafe the heart of the new community centre on Tarling Road
- Develop activities for children and young people, such as a summer play scheme
- Map out open spaces where new play areas can be built
- Set up a youth forum
- Run workshops and practical projects to help people find work and improve their skills
- Support local businesses and

encourage people to shop locally

- Endorse the development of an activity centre for older people
- Run an annual community festival

The plan has been built up over the past three years based on priorities identified by local residents over many months of consultation. Full details can be found at [www.grangebiglocal.org](http://www.grangebiglocal.org)

"The plan will enable a locally-led approach to making this corner of East Finchley a better place to live," said Julie Pal, CEO of CommUNITY Barnet, who will administer the funds and help the GBL to carry out the plan.

#### 11 Abbots Gardens, N2

Part single/part two storey side and rear extension, following demolition of garage.

#### 31 Abbots Gardens, N2

Replacing existing semi-detached house with two storey semi-detached, with rooms in roof and basement. Associated works.

#### Office 3, Ground Floor, 1 Bedford Mews, N2

Change of use from B1 to D1 use.

#### 9 Bedford Road, N2

Single storey rear extension.

#### 24 Brim Hill, N2

Single storey rear extension. Single storey rear outbuilding. One rear and one side dormer, with rear conservation roof light. to facilitate loft conversion. One refuse store to front of the property.

#### 40 Chandos Road, N2

Replacement of existing rear door with new access.  
Roof extensions, involving hip to gable end, rear dormer, 3 front roof lights and one roof light to

front projection Single storey rear extension following demolition of existing conservatory.

#### 56 Deansway, N2

Roof extensions, involving raising the height, one dormer window to south east, and one roof light each to north west and south west. New front porch. Living room extension within existing building footprint.

#### 139 Elmshurst Crescent, N2

Two storey rear extension

#### 141 Elmshurst Crescent, N2

Part single/part two storey rear extension, following demolition of existing extension.

#### 18 Hertford Road, N2

Single storey side and rear extension following demolition of existing extension.

#### 212 - 216 High Road, N2

Division of existing ground floor restaurant into two units. Removal of staircase at rear and construction of two new staircases to existing flats. Associated alterations to rear elevation, including two storey extension.

#### 24 Howard Walk, N2

Single storey rear extension. Loft conversion, involving rear dormer and one conservation roof light to side.

#### 8 Huntingdon Road, N2

Single storey side extension.

#### 11 Huntingdon Road, N2

Conversion from two self-contained flats into single family dwelling.

#### Ground Floor Flat, 2 Oak Lane, N2

Single storey rear extension including terrace to ground floor flat. New rear external staircase with associated railings and privacy screen to first floor flat and new access door.

#### Telecommunications Mast 70290, Strawberry Vale, N2

Replacing existing 13.7 metre high Phase 4 monopole and 3900A APM30H Version C cabinet with 15 metre high Phase 5 monopole and a stacked cabinet, measuring 600 x 480 x 1400mm, located at ground level. Associated development.
