### Sport Relief no obstacle for runners

Pupils at Martin Primary School put their best foot forward to raise money for Sport Relief. On 18 March all 660 children at the school, from nursery through to Year 6, took part in an obstacle course on the school field ranging from 960m to 1,800m.

They were cheered on by parents, staff and Connor Lynch, a youth coach from Barnet Football Club, as they jumped, crawled and ran around the course. The school raised £992 for the charity through donations and selling wrist bands.

Sports teacher Jeannette Adams, who organised the day, said: "Physical activity is so important for children. This was about getting all the children active and enjoying

themselves, while raising money for a good cause."

Connor Lynch added: "It is always good for children to be active when they are young and try new sports to see if it is something they want to pursue. Sport Relief is a fantastic cause and it is great to be part of it."

As well as taking part in the obstacle course race, some children in Year 2 were awarded medals for being young leaders. In total, Sport Relief raised more than £56 million this year.

### Basketball team unbeatable

The Senior Basketball team at Christ's College Finchley, pictured, completed a fantastic season by beating a team from St James' High School, Colindale, in a close and exciting Barnet League Final at Woodhouse College in North Finchley. The game was a fitting finale to an outstanding season in which the team had been unbeaten in Barnet competitions and represented the school in the English Schools National Cup for the first time.



### Traffic cameras

A new network of CCTV cameras has been introduced at 60 hotspots around Barnet in an attempt to improve road safety and to keep traffic moving.

Barnet Council will use the cameras to issue penalties to drivers committing illegal offences such as banned left and right turns or parking on a yellow zig-zag line near a school.
