We are the champions... twice over!

Young dancers from the Archer Academy competed against schools from 24 boroughs in the London Youth Games and waltzed off with gold medals in both the junior and senior competitions.

The school's two groups performed two very different pieces at the CopperBox Arena in the Olympic Park, one a powerful dance about catching a light and the other an emotional portrayal of connections and relationships.

Both performances impressed the judges and earned first place. It was the first time a Barnet school had won the London-wide competition and the first time any school had won gold in both categories.

No change in parking zone

Last June Barnet Council conducted a consultation amongst residents of the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in the Cherry Tree Wood area (*The Archer*, July 2016). The CPZ imposed here in 2004 has been a bone of contention for some and appeals have been made for changes.

The results of this latest survey were not revealed until February 2017, when the council stated: "The response rate of only 19% makes it difficult for officers to determine whether the responses are a good representation of the roads consulted."

Single-storey rear extension, following demolition of conservatory.

Roof extension with one dormer each side.

Single-storey rear infill extension. Replacement dormer extension windows. Three front roof lights.

32 Springcroft Avenue, N2

Rear/side ground floor infill extension, to replace single-storey rear extension.
