# Centenary building gives new look to Oak Lodge School

Oak Lodge School first opened in 1916 on a site in Oak Lane, N2. It relocated to Heath View in 1978, when it was an all-age school for children with special needs. In 1996 it became a secondary school, with a primary section being established at Northway, NW7. Now an academy, Oak Lodge recently celebrated the opening of its new Centenary Building.

Due to come into full use from September 2017, this additional accommodation will bring the school roll up to 194 students. It provides eight spacious classrooms, a therapy room, meeting spaces and a large sports hall, not forgetting staff rooms and planning areas. A lift connects the two floors as does a wide staircase.

Initially the building is intended for the new academic year's intake of Year 7 students. Howeverthere are more plans for the development of the school, involving six new classrooms for Key Stage 4 pupils as well as accommodation for post-16 students, all resident in the borough of Barnet. Oak Lodge has National Autistic Society Accreditation and outstanding grades from Ofsted.

Head teacher Lynda Walker told *The Archer* that she is delighted with the investment the local authority has made in Oak Lodge, which shows their support for students with special needs and enables them to celebrate 100 years of special education in Barnet.
