Go-ahead for flats in face of objections

Meanwhile, approximately 300 metres away in East End Road, the car park at the rear of Budgens and Iceland is to be occupied by a new block of eight flats following a decision by the Planning Inspectorate to allow an appeal by developers Livemanor against Barnet Council's refusal of permission.

Here, the objections concern the restricted space for delivery lorries serving the two supermarkets and other shops in Viceroy Parade. The Inspectorate ruled that lorries up to

14.25m would still have room to manoeuvre in the parking area. Budgens had objected on the grounds that its lorries are 16.5m long. There are fears that vehicles unable to access the rear of the stores will be forced to unload on the High Road.

Local residents also objected to the scale of the development and to the loss of public parking spaces but the Inspectorate said the new flats would "sit comfortably" between the flats of Viceroy Parade and the mosque further along East End Road.

Free cycle security sessions

Bike owners can have their trusty two-wheelers checked and minor faults fixed for free at monthly Dr Bike sessions outside East Finchley tube station.

With police officers in attendance, there's also the chance to get advice on protecting bikes and to get them security marked.

At the Dr Bike in January the police security marked 29 bikes and the bicycle mechanics checked and fixed 22 bikes.

Sessions usually take place on a Thursday evening in the first week of the month but keep watch for notices with precise dates.

Barnet Council's cycling officer is also promoting free cycle skills training to all individuals who live, work or



study in the borough. Anyone aged 16 or older will be able to find courses to suit their abilities and become a safe and
