## Advertising sign will be 'dangerous eyesore'

Plans have been submitted to construct a large digital advertising sign on a green island alongside the High Road and the North Circular.

Roadside advertising company JCDecaux wants to erect the 6m x 3m LED display sign on land where the east-bound North Circular slip road curves round to meet the High Road at the junction with Squires Lane, N12, close to the leisure and cinema complex.

Objectors to the plan say the sign will be an eyesore and a dangerous distraction to drivers at a busy intersection.

Stewart Wild, of Cyprus Road, N3, said: "Apart from aesthetics and its hideous profile harming the urban

landscape, this sign would be a serious danger to road users. Drivers will by definition be distracted, for that is the obvious purpose of the sign."

In its application, JCDecaux argues that the advertising sign will not be out of place on such a busy commercial route and is unlikely to be a safety hazard. No trees will be affected.

## Planning Applications

Single-storey rear extension. New patio area. Removal of side window. Increase in size to first-floor outrigger. Roof extension involving rear dormer window and two front rooflights.

Roof extension, including one

L-shaped rear dormer, outrigger with Juliette balcony, and three front rooflights. Demolition of conservatory. Alterations to window and access openings to rear garden.

Roof extension involving rear dormer window and two rear rooflights.

### 21 Manor Park Road, N2

Single-storey rear extension. Depth 5.4 m, eaves height 2.8 m, maximum height 3 m.

### 39 Manor Park Road, N2

Single-storey rear extension. Depth 6 m, eaves height 3 m, maximum height 3.3 metres.

### Old Barn Youth Club and Land Adjacent Corner Of Fallows Close And Tarling Road, N2

Details of conditions pursuant to planning permission.

### 21-25 Viceroy Parade, High Road, N2

Two storage containers and plant equipment to rear of store (part retrospective).

### Haringey Council 26 Whittington Court, Aylmer Road, N2

Replacement of non-original timber windows with double glazed thin section aluminium, mimicking layout, opening style, colour and glazing bar layout of original.
